1-Memorise the whole surah Al-Naba النبا

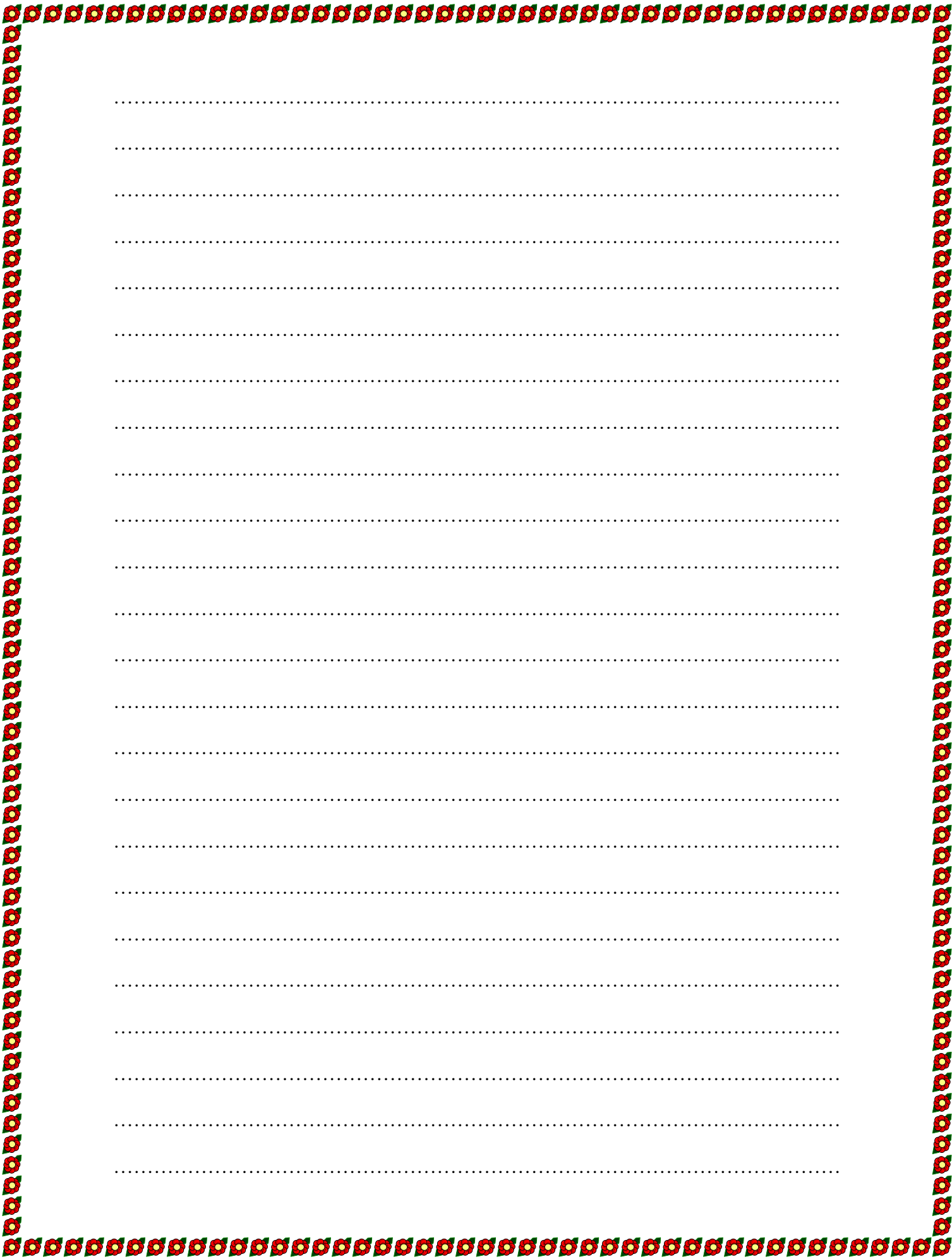
2- Revise from surah Al-Duhaa الضحى to surah Al-Nas الناس
